I commit to:

- Lead by example in promoting safety, transparency, and accountability, with zero tolerance of abuse, exploitation, bullying, harassment, or boundary violations.
- Listen and respond well to anyone who raises a concern, placing the wellbeing of the person at risk first, and ensuring pastoral support is available.
- Report concerns promptly to the appropriate statutory authorities and Church safeguarding bodies, and cooperate fully with investigations and procedures.
- Ensure safer recruitment and suitability, including required checks, references, role clarity, supervision, and ongoing review.
- Require safeguarding training and regular refreshers for SVD members, employees, and volunteers engaged in ministry or pastoral contact.
- Embed risk assessment and safe practice in all SVD activities, events, and pastoral settings, including clear codes of conduct.
- Maintain sound safeguarding governance, with clear roles, accurate records, regular review/audit, and timely action on findings.

I accept personal responsibility to ensure these commitments are implemented consistently across the District and that appropriate action is taken whenever safeguarding standards are not met.
